What is the Plan?

The Compatible Use Plan IS:

- A community-led project
- A collaborative process among communities such as City of Fairborn, City of Beavercreek, City of Dayton, City of Huber Heights, City of Riverside, Bath Township; Miami Valley Regional Planning Commission; Miami Conservancy District; Wright-Patterson Regional Council of Governments; Wright-Patterson AFB; and other local, state, and federal agencies
- A body of information that assists in making more informed decisions
- A study that recommends appropriate actions for each jurisdiction/agency

The Compatible Use Plan IS NOT:

- A regulatory document
- An enforceable action


